Abstract submission:

Abstracts can be published only by those participants who plan to participate personally in the conference with a report or as a listener.

Abstract language: English.

Abstract submission rules: The abstracts are accepted only in electronic form in the text editor Word (version 97 and higher). The number of abstracts from the first author is not more than two.

Abstract volume: abstracts are accepted with a maximum of 1 page of text, 2 cm margins (top, bottom, left and right), line spacing 1.5 lines, Times Roman font, size 14 pt.

The order of abstract submission: title of abstract; surnames and initials of authors; official name of the organization, city, contacts of the responsible person (phone, e-mail); abstract body.

Abstract submission deadline — June 01, 2018.

Abstract submission is free of charge.

Abstracts should be sent by e-mail: conference@scaf-spb.ru with the attached file Word document with indication in the subject line “*publication of theses in the materials of the conference “Mental Recovery”*”

Oral presentation:

Plenary report — 20 minutes.

Oral report — 10 minutes.

Presentation of clinical observation — 8 minutes.

Applications for oral reports are accepted together with the abstracts **until June 1, 2018.**

The decision about the type of presentation will be made by the Program committee and emailed to you **by August 10, 2018.**

The Organizing Committee has the right to limit the number of oral reports and to offer only publication of abstracts.
